Location

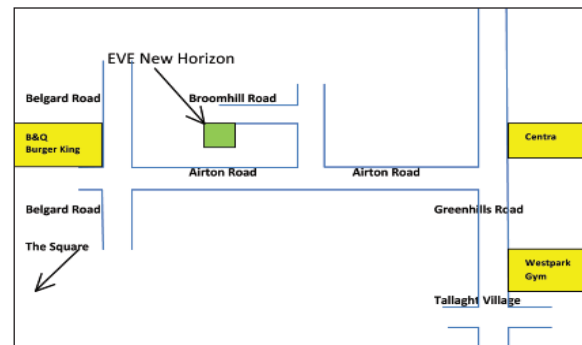
EVE New Horizon is located off the Airton Road in Tallaght. Travelling from the Belgard Road (from the Square): Take the right turn at the traffic lights at B&Q and Burger King onto the Airton Road. Take the 1st left turn onto Broomhill Road (there will be a post-box at this corner). Take the next left turn onto Broomhill Close. EVE New Horizon is the last unit on the left-hand side.

Travelling from the Greenhills Road (from Tallaght Village): Coming from the village pass by Westpark gym on your righthand side. Take the left turn at the next traffic lights onto the Airton Road. Take the 1st right turn onto Broomhill Road (there will be a post-box at this corner). Take the next left turn onto Broomhill Close. EVE New Horizon is the last unit on the left-hand side.

A Training Opportunity for You

EVE New Horizon is part of EVE. EVE is a programme within the HSE, who's primary ethos is to provide community-based recovery-orientated programmes for adults who experience mental health difficulties, intellectual difficulties, Asperger's Syndrome, and Physical and Sensory disabilities. We do this through our network of Vocational, Rehabilitative and Clubhouse services in 21 locations across HSE Dublin North East and HSE Dublin Mid-Leinster regions. EVE New Horizon is a Rehabilitative Training centre within this programme providing a service for people who experience mental health difficulties.

Our Programme

We offer a programme which is person centred. 50% of training time is focused on certification and the other 50% of time is available for choice based modules. This ensures people get the most from their training time. Our centre in Tallaght provides a location that allows a person to work on their mental health recovery through education and positive community integration.
